Landscape Committee News



The leaves are beginning to fall and the rain is here. The HPCA property is very large and Brightview will be actively blowing and removing leaves. The Edgewater neighborhood is broken up into three weekly sections. During each weekly section the sidewalks and walkways of that area will be blown off regularly. The streets will be blown once a month or more often depending on time it takes. During the fourth week, they will focus on all of the common areas including the trail, Eagles Bluff and Woodland Cove areas. They will focus on edging of flower beds and driveways in Edgewater as this should be done twice a month and has not been completed. They will be removing dead plants from flower beds and pruning will begin in January to March. The purpose of the lack of pruning this year was to create a healthier better looking community in the forthcoming spring.
